It is an international gastronomic society dedicated to bringing together professional and non-professional members from around the world who appreciate wine, cuisine and fine dining. With over 25,000 members in more than seventy countries, the Chaîne is forever expanding and evolving through the creation of new "Baillages". One unique point about the Chaîne is that membership is transferable worldwide. This means that if you become a Chaîne member in one country and then for professional or personal reasons you move to another country, your membership is still valid. Additionally, it also allows you to be part of the Chaîne's international network and participate in Chaîne events and activities in different countries across the globe. The society also supports and promotes the future of young cooks and Sommeliers, and sponsors several food release programs through the Chaîne Foundation.
